Catch Me If You Can: When Emotions Run Away: Emotions aren't good or bad. They're like aches and pains, junk drawers, and that brownish-orange, fuzzy floral patterned furniture at grandma's house. Everybody's got em'. This course highlights eight major human emotions. Each session explores an emotion, what happens when it goes rogue, and ways to maneuver a derailed emotional train back onto its tracks. Eight-week groups for men, women, and co-ed starting after Spring Break.

The Gift of Being Yourself: Can there be deep knowledge of God without deep knowledge of self? This study is about knowing God through knowing ourselves. This book gets beneath the crust of ego and past persona and behind image to the truth of you. Here is a pathway to discover and receive the beloved, unrepeatable self that God designed you to be. A six-week study in the Wesley Classroom beginning April 9th at noon.
